On September 9th, 2020, Hospice Quinte was joined by Bay of Quinte MPP Todd Smith, Quinte West Mayor Jim Harrison, Belleville Mayor Mitch Panciuk and other local dignitaries for a special groundbreaking ceremony to officially kick-off construction of the new Hospice Quinte Care Centre.

Our construction team has been working hard since the groundbreaking three months ago, and we are extremely excited to share this update regarding construction progress of the Hospice Quinte Care Centre.

During the months of November and December we've seen the exterior of the building go up, including walls and roof trusses. Peak Construction Group, our general contractor for the project, has worked hard to stay on schedule and has completed a lot of site work, including soil preparation and underground trenching. A significant amount of underground electrical and mechanical work has also been completed.

Peak is currently working on putting plywood on the

roof, and installing windows and doors, which should be complete by the end of December to prepare for winter construction. In January 2021, Peak will continue to focus on interior work, such as plumbing, electrical, in-floor heating pipes and interior fire sprinkler system.

We are forever thankful for every donation that we have received to make Quinte's dream of a Hospice Quinte Care Centre a reality. It is the generosity and support of people like you that has allowed us to progress quickly and successfully with the construction.
